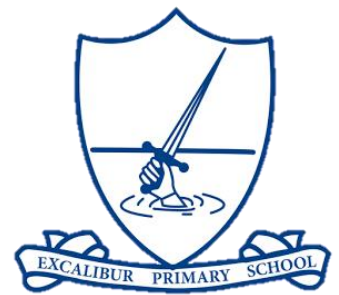

Dear Parents and Carers,

We would like to take this opportunity to welcome you all back. What an incredibly strange and testing 12 months it has been. The strength, support and flexibility you have shown during this time has been incredible. Under very difficult circumstances, you have ensured that your children have continued to learn. We would like to thank you for your continued cooperation and for working with the school to support your child's education during the period of school closure.

We are delighted to be welcoming our children back into school and hope that we will not have to go through another period of lockdown. However, it is important that we prepare for the possibility of future individual isolation or class/ school closures.

Should it become necessary to fully or partially close our school, or provide learning for isolating individuals, we have updated our remote learning provision to ensure that all pupils continue to receive a high-quality education outside of school. Details of our remote learning strategy can be found on our website.

Should any pupil need to self-isolate (individual isolation), they will have the opportunity to access the morning lessons of maths and English being taught in school via Microsoft Teams. An invite will be sent out by the class teacher. Afternoon sessions will be available on the class page and will include pre-recorded teaching using a high-quality resource. In our Reception Class, there will be a mixture of live lessons, if it is appropriate, and pre-recorded lessons. As I am sure you will appreciate, some younger children may find joining a live session from the classroom quite overwhelming.

Should a class be required to isolate, live teaching in maths and English will be provided where the class teacher is able to do so (As previously outlined, in our Reception Class, the teaching will be a mixture of live or pre-recorded). Afternoon sessions will be as with individual isolation. If a class teacher is unable to provide live lessons due to illness, pre-recorded videos will be made available on the class page.
