This week after listening to the story of Cinderella we looked at lots of different versions of the story comparing them to the original. We looked at 'Interstellar Cinderella' which is set in space, 'Prince Cinders', 'Princess Smarty-pants' and 'The Egyptian Cinderella'.

We looked at different types of footwear, learning about what they are used for, what they are made from and talking about which ones we liked and why. Other learning saw some of us make magic wands, cast spells and build castles and vehicles to get Cinderella home from the ball. We also wrote about what we would wish for if we were granted a wish.

In our maths learning we continued to explore the composition of numbers to 10. We talked about which numbers were more and some of us were able to say how many more. Today we explored 'magic dice' as we learned that the numbers on opposite sides add to 7. After rolling a die we were able to say which number would be on the bottom of the die. This is a great game to play at home too.

We made Easter crosses and an Easter garden ready for next week.
