Dear Parents/Carers,

We are planning to take our Year 6 pupils on a residential course to Laches Wood between the 29<sup>th</sup> September to 1<sup>st</sup> October 2021. As I'm sure you know, residential visits organised by the school are an optional but invaluable part of the National Curriculum. Children benefit enormously from the experience, both educationally and socially and I feel certain that the course we have chosen will prove to be both enjoyable and worthwhile.

Laches Wood is a modern Entrust outdoor centre which combines exciting outdoor and indoor activities all taking place in a controlled environment. Previous Year 6 children have had a very enjoyable stay at this centre and were able to gain experience of climbing, zip wires, caving and canoeing to name but a few of the opportunities on offer.

There will be a meeting for parents later in the year (date to be confirmed) where we will be able to show you a video and explain about the centre and the educational experiences which will be available.

The total cost of the visit which includes: travel between the school and Laches Wood; full board accommodation; and a full programme of activities will be £167.72 per child. The initial deposit to reserve a place for your child is £55.90.

If you would like your child to take part, please grant consent and pay for the initial deposit on ParentMail via the shop.

The trip cost has been split into instalments due on the following dates:-
