Pre-school Class Newsletter Term: Autumn 1 Week: two

This week, we have continued with our 'Incy Wincy Spider' theme for our Nursery Rhyme topic. The children have enjoyed joining with a variety of action songs and nursery rhymes. They have begun to suggest their favourites during carpet time. They have created their own string spider webs, using gloopy glue. They also used their fine motor skills to collect plastic spiders using tweezers. We then counted how many, before the sand timer ran out.



During creative activities, we have spent lots of time mark making and colour mixing with paint and chalks. The children loved shaping and modelling with play dough. The Peppa pig small world toys and floor puzzle were also a big hit this week. Next week, we move on to activities planned around the nursery rhyme 'Humpty Dumpty'.

Pre-school joined in with the rest of the school when we celebrated 'International Dot Day'. The children got creative and helped to create a beautiful piece of artwork for a display.
