Another busy week has literally raced by and the children have been involved in a variety of exciting learning opportunities. Earlier this week, they made their own butter which they enjoyed on a CraCker at snack-time. They have been busy making marks and writing in glitter sand. The children have also had the chance to show what they already know during our Reception Baseline activities. This will provide some useful information concerning the children's individual next steps of learning.



In maths, we have been busy touch counting objects. We talked about the great strategies that some of the Children employed. These included, counting and saying number names slowly, moving objects into a line or taking objects out of the pile as we said each number name. The Children also went on to combine two groups of objects to find the new total.

The Children have loved starting our Read, Write Inc. program this week. They have been focusing on sounds m, s, a and d. We have also looked at the formation of these letters and the children have been encouraged to practise them in the glitter sand and on the white boards. We will slowly introduce all set one letters to the children and the formation rhymes to help them begin to record sounds in words.
