Welcome back to a most exciting half term. We have launched straight into our "People Who Help Us" mini topic and the children have loved exploring the new role-play Police Station. Everyone has made their own official police badge.

In literacy, the Children talked about all the people who help us and shared their ideas with one another. We recorded lists of people who help us. The Children had to listen Carefully to hear the sounds in the words they wanted to record.

During topic work, the children have found out about Bonfire night and the story of Guy Fawkes. We have talked about keeping safe during Bonfire Celebrations and have read the Firework code. The children have been busy Creating model rockets, Chalking firework pictures, and have developed firework dances.

In Read Write Inc, the Children used letter tiles to spell requested CVC words. They used their "Pointer of Power" to sound out and blend across the words. We continued to add new sounds o and C as well as recapping the sounds so far.

In maths, we have explored 2D and 3D shapes. The Children went out and about on a shape hunt around the school grounds. They also enjoyed using marshmallows and picks to construct different shapes.
