Mrs Choi showed some of the equipment she used and how she gives someone an eye test. Many thanks to Mrs Choi for her time and efforts.

The children made very sensible suggestions about what we should and shouldn't do. We discussed making 999 calls if there was ever a real emergency and the importance of the children knowing their home address. The children made fire safety posters to remind people to "Get out and stay out!" and we sang our "I am a fire-fighter" song. We also have a visit from the Fire service to look forward to (booked for the beginning of December).

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In Read Write Inc, the children have been working hard to select and position the magnetic letter tiles to spell CVC words. They have been introduced to their "Perfect Partners" and have used their "Pointer of Power" to blend and read across the words.

On Friday, we showed our support for "Children in Need" by wearing it spotty. The children enjoyed icing biscuits and spotting them with smarties. They painted Pudsey bear pictures and we talked about kindness.
