Everyone tried hard to record their answers, representing numbers with marks or number like shapes. We looked at numbers 1 to 5 and noticed how the numbers were formed.

On Thursday, everyone looked amazing dressed up as their favourite nursery rhyme character. We spent time going through the different rhymes represented by each child. We celebrated WNRW with a 'Nursery Rhyme' tea party and took part in activities including: Nursery Rhyme Bingo, 3D Hickory Dickory mice models and the 'Wheels on the Bus' role play.
