

On Wednesday, we had our "Bring a Bear" day. The children made name labels and crowns for their bears. They measured their bears and compared them with other children's bears. We took them out on a real bear hunt around the school grounds and acted out the story. In the afternoon, the children made yummy honey and marmalade sandwiches to share during snack time.



During topic work, the children have explored ice and melting. They have investigated different ways to make their ice balloons melt more quickly. We have also been learning about the polar regions and the animals who live there. The children had lots of interesting questions. We plan to set up a play tray in the classroom with some polar regions resources to explore.

In maths, we have been exploring pattern. The children have enjoyed making their own repeating patterns. We have also practised counting in tens, twos and fives.
