We continued our "Terrific Transport" focus this week. The children loved the chance to take part in some drama activities involving a railway station. We introduced a remote-control prop which allowed us to play, pause and freeze frame the drama. The children also loved lining up the Chairs to make their own pretend train. The children have enjoyed Creating 3D vehicles in the "Make and Do" area. They have tried hard to add finer details to make them more like the real thing. The children have also been writing tickets to take a journey to a chosen destination.

In Read Write Inc, the Children have been working hard to "see and say" some simple green words (if they recognise them) without needing to "Fred" them. We have had a focus on supporting our perfect partners to ensure individuals equally participate.

In maths, we have been using positional and directional language. The children have been encouraged to give and receive a set of instructions. They have also found out how to program our floor robot (Bee Bot) to send it on a journey around an obstacle course. We have continued to count in twos, tens and fives.

The children have also taken part in "Internet Safety Day". They had a special assembly led by Mrs Bailey and took part in some activities to help them understand how to use the internet safely.
