















World This week, we found out about llamas, as we joined in with some 'Passport to the World' activities. The children enjoyed wool wrapping their own llama template.

Gemma, who goes into lots of different settings, was impressed with how well the children were responding to the activities. Well done everyone!

On Wednesday, the children showed how independent they are becoming when they changed for PE. All the children were trying super hard when managing own clothing and fastens. Keep it up everyone! During PE, we travelled in different ways e.g. galloping, side steps and marching. We also practiced our catching and throwing skills with coloured beanbags.

## Number Time



This week, we have been consolidating some of our learning so far. We recognised and named 2D shapes (including pentagon) and talked about their properties. Everyone helped Foxy guess the numbers as they were slowly revealed from their hiding place. We looked closely at numerals 1 to 5 and counted objects, up to 5, with accurate 1:1.
