If you only give your child juice and they spill the contents or wish to replenish it, we can only offer filtered water. During the very hot weather last year we sometimes had to refill the bottles 2 or 3 times in a day to keep the children hydrated. It's in their best interests that they get used to drinking water. Thank you for your understanding.
