Dear Parents/Carers,

Well, Spring has finally sprung! It's been lovely for the children to be out playing under blue skies (and a few rain clouds) and there are beautiful signs for spring popping up around the school grounds.

Barnaby Bear

The year one children have worked so hard over the past 6 weeks, learning a selection of songs about Barnaby Bear and his travels around the world. This all culminated in a performance at Congleton Town Hall alongside other schools. Their behaviour and performance skills were outstanding. Miss Taylor and the other accompanying staff were incredibly proud. Well done year 1!

School Uniform

We have had a number of children coming into school without unsuitable footwear for the school day. Whilst we understand that there are sometimes extenuating circumstances that mean they need different footwear for a short period, this cannot be a permanent arrangement.

Haematology Session

As part of Science Week, Year 6 were visited by two scientists who are trained in haematology. Following the study of biomedical science at university, they then went to work at Royal Stoke Hospital and the linked university. During the session, the children learnt about the key components of the blood (platelets, plasma, white blood cells and red blood cells) and how there are eight different blood types.

Year 2 Multi-Skills Session

On Thursday 14th March, a group of Year 2 children attended a multi-skills session at Alsager School. During the event, they took part in a variety of sporting activities, including agility courses, team games and coordination activities. The session was led by the sports ambassadors from the Alsager primary schools, including Joel, Ella and Emma from Excalibur. Well done to everyone who took part.

Alsager Schools - Year 5 and 6 Swimming Gala

This was held on Tuesday 19th March at Alsager Leisure Centre. Organised jointly by Alsager School and Alsager Swimming Club. Excalibur Primary School sent a team of 17 pupil (8 from Year 6 and 9 from Year 5) to the event.

The gala consisted of 8 individual races, along with 4 competitive relays and a fun canon relay to finish. Excalibur had a strong showing in the individual races, with 3 first place finishes for Emma (Yr 6) in the Girls 25m Front Crawl, Harriet (Yr 5) in the Girls 25m Backstroke and Ella (Yr 6) in the Girls 25m Breaststroke. Some fantastic team performances in the relays enabled Excalibur to win 2 out of the 4 relays, including an impressive swim from the Girls Medley Team who won their race by nearly a full length!

The final standings saw Excalibur taking a very respectable 2nd place with 42 points overall, which was just 5 points away for St Gabriels in 1st place with 47 points! Some were a little disappointed and frustrated at just how close the team had come to winning the trophy, they should however all be exceptionally proud of their achievements and the commitment, enthusiasm, and support that they showed for one another on the day. Well done guys, you did Excalibur proud.
