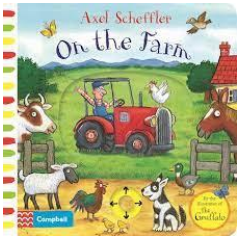

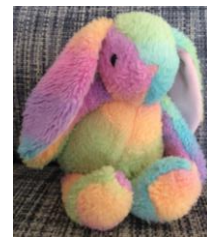
During maths, we have shared some consolidation activities from our learning so far. We also revisited some of our number rhymes and songs.
