




















## Pre-school Weekly Newsletter Term: Summer one Week: one



Our story of the week was 'Dear Zoo'.



Our number rhyme of the week was 'Five Little Man' which the children were very keen to join in with.

Welcome to the summer term. It was so lovely to see the children back at preschool this week. We have missed them!

This week, we have begun our new topic 'Dear Zoo'. The children enjoyed hearing the story read and we shared conversations about why the animals wouldn't make good pets. Everyone agreed that the giraffe was far too tall and the children thought a rhinoceros would spoil everything with it's horn. A crocodile was added to the story and we talked about how he would need a long box to be delivered. The children also talked about other animals that made good pets.

On Monday, everyone was excited to see Gemma for Rhythm Time. The children learnt about crescendo and how we start quietly and get louder. They especially enjoyed the louder parts!

During maths time, we have been sequencing familiar events and using vocabulary to explain our order e.g. first, next, then, after that, last. The children have ordered pictures depicting a morning routine, nursery rhymes and the story of the hungry caterpillar. They then had to check the sequence made sense.

On Thursday, we spent much of the time outdoors. The children enjoyed exploring the pre-school area; making sand pies, filling and pouring in our water tray, blowing bubbles and rolling the outdoor hoops. Fingers crossed we get lots of sunshine over the next few weeks!
