

Reception Autumn walk along Merelake Way – Wednesday 17th October



On Wednesday 17th October, depending on the weather, we are planning to take the children on a short walk along Merelake Way, the salt line, as far as the Roman bridge. We will be using our senses to look, listen and touch as we walk along. We will be collecting interesting leaves, seeds, small twigs etc that we will use back at school.

We are planning to leave school as soon as we are ready at approximately 9.20 am, returning to school late morning, in plenty of time for lunch.

We will provide the children with a snack for the walk so they won't need to bring or buy a snack that day. If the walk has to be cancelled due to the weather, we will still ensure they have a snack.

Children will need to wear a warm waterproof coat. They should wear their usual school t-shirt and jumper or cardigan. However, they can wear jeans, trousers or leggings instead of their school trousers or skirt.

We will be wearing our wellies for the walk. However if your child has walking boots/outdoor footwear they are welcome to wear that instead. Please ensure they have a pair of shoes to change into when we return to school.

If you are free on the Wednesday morning we would love it if you could come along. Grandparents are welcome too! The walk is unsuitable for pushchairs and younger siblings.
