Englesea Brook Chapel and Museum

We are delighted to announce that on Monday 3rd December, Year 6 will be visiting Englesea Brook Chapel & Museum. During the day, they will be taking part in science themed activities and they will get the opportunity to have a tour of the historic building, including the 19th Century printing press.

The experience is intended to extend the children's knowledge of science with some hands-on approaches as well as enabling them to gain a broader understanding of the local area, with particular focus on Hugh Bourne, a Methodist vicar with a keen interest in teaching science to the children in his congregation.

At the start of the day, they will take part in a formal, Victorian-era school class, which will set the scene with regards to the time at which Hugh Bourne lived. The rest of the day will be dedicated to the science activities, which will include water and air pressure, heat exchange and organs of the body amongst other things.

The children will leave school at 9.30am and will be back at school in time for the end of the school day. A packed lunch in a disposable bag will be required which they will eat in the historic chapel - no fizzy drinks or glass bottles please. The children need to wear normal school uniform.

The cost of the visit is £7.75. As you know, we always ask for a voluntary contribution to help offset the cost of transport and admission fees. Unfortunately, if this voluntary contribution is not forthcoming then the visit will not be able to take place.
