They asked some very good questions, supporting their understanding of what happens in a church and why people go there. Ton Tuesday, the children were excited to visit Crewe Lyceum to watch the excellent, adventures of "The Stick Man". They listened carefully as the storyline unfolded and laughed out loud at the humorous parts. Both the Reception children and Year one children represented Excalibur beautifully with outstanding behaviour.

We used our theatre visit to fuel our learning opportunities this week. They made and used stick man rulers to explore and measure objects around the room. Everyone tried hard to line up the scale to measure more accurately. All of the children created their own fantastic stick man character using the sticks they had brought into school. The children enjoyed taking their stick men out of the classroom for a walk around the school grounds. They joined in with the actions as we acted out the story on our own stick man journey.

The fire service was our "People who help us" focus this week. We recalled what happened when we had our practice fire drill, in school, and discussed what to do if there was ever a fire at home. The children made very sensible suggestions about what we should and shouldn't do. We discussed making 999 calls if there was ever a real emergency and the importance of the children knowing their home address. The children made fire safety posters to remind people to "Get out and stay out!" and we sang our "I am a fire-fighter" song. On Wednesday, we had a visit from the Fire service and the children had chance to sit in a real fire engine. They loved helping to squirt the water from the hose. What a busy week!
