We learnt a big maths word this week too, 'subitising', this means we can recall the number rolled on a die without counting the spots.

The children have been trying hard to create a line drawing of themselves to go on our 'Marvellous Me' display in the classroom. These drawings will be added to as the year goes on. We have also made a class book entitled 'My Family' which is full of drawings of our families.

We listened to the story of 'Giraffe's Can't Dance' and sang along to Mr Tumble's 'Shining Stars' song. Then thought about the different things that we were shining stars at. The children were very good at listening to their friends and patiently waiting for their turn to speak.
