



## Christmas Card Project

This year the school will again be participating in the Christmas Card project.

The Project takes a design that your child creates and turns it into professional cards, gift wrap and gift tags that you then have the option to purchase if you wish. A donation is made back to the school for each item purchased.

If your child doesn't fancy making a Christmas card, then this year they have the option to make a card of their choice - perhaps a birthday card which they can then send to their friends throughout the year, 'thank you' cards or party invitations are other suggestions.

Also this year, it is opened up to anyone who would like to complete a design - teachers, parents, siblings - all able to complete a design if they would like to. Alternatively, siblings can also create a joint design if they wish.

Each child will be sent home on Monday 30th September with a piece of card for them to create their design on, and they will have two weeks to complete it.

If additional pieces of card are required then these can be collected from the school reception.

Further details will be sent out next week, including hints and tips regarding what works well for designs. See below for some early ideas.
