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On Thursday 17th October, depending on the weather, we are planning to take the Children on a short walk along Merelake Way, the salt line, as far as the Roman bridge. We will be using our senses to look, listen and feel as we walk along. We will be collecting interesting leaves, seeds, small twigs etc that we will use back at school.

We are planning to leave school as soon as we are ready at approximately 9.15 am, returning to school late morning, in plenty of time for lunch.

We will provide the children with a snack for the walk. They won't need to bring or buy a snack that day. If the walk has to be cancelled due to the weather, we will still ensure they still have a snack.

If you are free on the Thursday morning we would love it if you could come along. Grandparents/aunts/uncles are welcome too! We would politely ask that younger siblings do not attend. Please grant permission via ParentMail as possible before Thursday 17th October.
