Reception Class Newsletter

We are starting to think about autumn this week. We talked about the different seasons and shared the story 'The Tiny Seed'. Conkers, acorns and helicopter seeds have all caught our interest this week too. Pumpkins have been measured, weighed, rolled and examined. We found out how they grow, with the help of some time lapse photography, and that they grow above rather than under the ground.

Freed In Read, Write Inc. the children have been learning the sound and formation of letters p, g, o and c. We have also been practising the speed sounds so far and have continued to use them to build CVC with magnetic tiles.

We have discussed how to stay healthy and what happens to our teeth if we have too much sugar.

<u>Home learning</u>

In the past we have sent out home learning activities you can do with your child at home, to support their learning in school. These were sent out in two folders, one for maths and one for phonics, in a zip bag.

This year we are trialling putting the activities on the class web page instead. You will need to visit the Reception class webpage each Friday when new home learning activities will be uploaded.
