Y6 Trip to Englesea Brook

On Friday 29th November, Year 6 visited Englesea Brook Chapel & Museum to take part in a sciencethemed day. During the day, the children took part in a variety of STEM (science, technology, engineering and maths) activities which will support their learning in school throughout the year. In particular, the children observed the wonders of light through a demonstration of a traditional light-box and made their own prints using a pre-20th century Atlas printing press. They also listened to early 20th century gramophones and discussed the method by which the sound was transferred and amplified. After lunch on the chapel pews, Reverend Hatcher, adopted the role of Methodist Hugh Bourne. As usual, everyone at Englesea Brook was wonderful - many thanks to all of them for making the day possible.
