

1,2,3 Writing - Journey...

Task: write a first-person narrative detailing a child's journey over the ice to a destination of your choice.



Before you start, you need to decide on the destination: where is your character going to go to? Some ideas below:

- School
- A castle
- A cabin
- A portal to another world
- Etc.

The following is a suggestion for what to include in each section (you decide when to paragraph based on TiPTop: time, place, topic or person). You may use this if you wish.

Section 1: Description of the location, along with any detail about who you are with.

Section 2: Something happens, such as a blizzard starting or an accident.

Section 3: You reach the destination. Build suspense in this section before revealing what it is (if you wish) in the final sentence.

What must be included?

- 1st person (I, me, my, our,)
- Range of sentence structures:
 - Once we had reached the ice shelf, we edged our way onto the sheet, careful to avoid the cracks which had started to form.
 - Desperate and determined, we trod bravely onwards through the horizontal sleet.
 - I was stunned, surprised, astounded, by what stood before us.
 - I stepped onto the ice.
- Ambitious vocabulary
- Basic punctuation (full stops, commas, capital letters)

Please note: the piece of writing should take up about 1 and a half pages of writing (A4). If you are writing on a computer, it should be in font size 14 and approximately a page.
