- Use time connectives (this morning, after that, before long, at first, in the meantime, at that moment)
- Appropriate tense
  - Past tense to describe events on the island,
  - Present tense to describe how you are feeling now,
  - Future tense to share your worries and concerns about Lucy.
- Share thoughts/feelings
  - How you felt on the island,
  - How you felt about the actions of your dad,
  - How you feel towards Lucy.
