<u>Planning Template – Film Review</u>

You are aiming for five short sections. The planning template below should guide you with what to include. Use this in conjunction with the **WAGOLL**, **Phrase and Sentence Bank** and **Film Terminology**.

Section	What to include
1. Introduction	 Hook your reader and make them want to read on.
2. A short synopsis	 What is the film about? Do this without revealing any spoilers. Summarise the plot – don't go into excessive detail.
3. Interesting information about the film	 Include information about the cast or crew, or any awards the film has received.
4. What you like and dislike and why	 What do you like about the film? Why? What do you dislike about the film? Why Include terminology, or jargon, of the film industry (see Film Terminology document for more information).
5. Summarise	- Briefly summarise your review. Make it an effective, engaging ending.

Essentials:

- Write in first person.
- Write in present tense. Ex. The film is a masterpiece.
