

## Planning Template – Chapter One

Your task is to write the first chapter of a story. It should be engaging for the reader and end in a way that makes the reader want to read more. You are aiming for four or five sections, but this will vary depending on your story. The planning template below can be used to plan your sections. You may use my **WAGOLL** to give you a general idea of what to do as well.

<u>Section</u>	<u>What to include</u>
1. Setting the scene	- Set the scene. <i>Where does your story take place?</i>
2.	- Introduce the characters. <i>What characters will you have in this chapter?</i>
3.	- Section 3 and 4 should include the build-up of the story to the cliffhanger at the end of the chapter.
4.	5. Section 3 and 4 should include the build-up of the story to the cliffhanger at the end of the chapter.
6. End of chapter	- End the chapter in a way that makes the reader want to read on. - <i>What is going to happen at the end of your chapter?</i>
