With the end of this half term already upon us, we wanted to take the opportunity to share with you the latest activities that have been taking place in school and wish you a lovely half term break.

Passport to the World

During the week beginning 16th May, the whole school took part in our annual "Passport to the World" week. Throughout the week, the children spent time learning about a host of different countries from all over the world.

In Morocco, inspired by the distinctive architecture, the children created their own symmetrical designs using tiles; in Japan, they practised calligraphy by writing essential Japanese phrases; In New Zealand, they honed their Haka and played a traditional Māori game; In Italy, they looked at some maps and found out some iconic places in the country; In Australia, they designed their own aboriginal art and created a flag; in Kenya, they created flags and masks. What a fabulous and busy week it was, learning about the culture and customs of other countries.

Year 3 & 4 Tennis Tournament

On Thursday 19th May, a group of six Year 3 & 4 children competed in the annual Year 3 & 4 tennis tournament as part of the Alsager Community Trust. During the event, they competed in doubles matches against pairs from other schools.

Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 Computing Session with Raj Barard

The choir then accompanied the dancers with renditions of a range of songs, including the always-popular *Celebration Time*.
