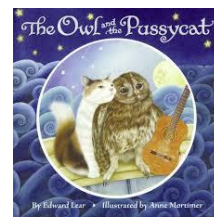
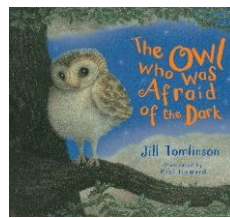
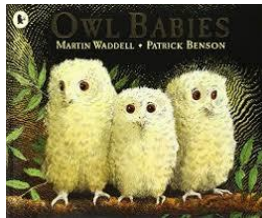




Hi everyone,
