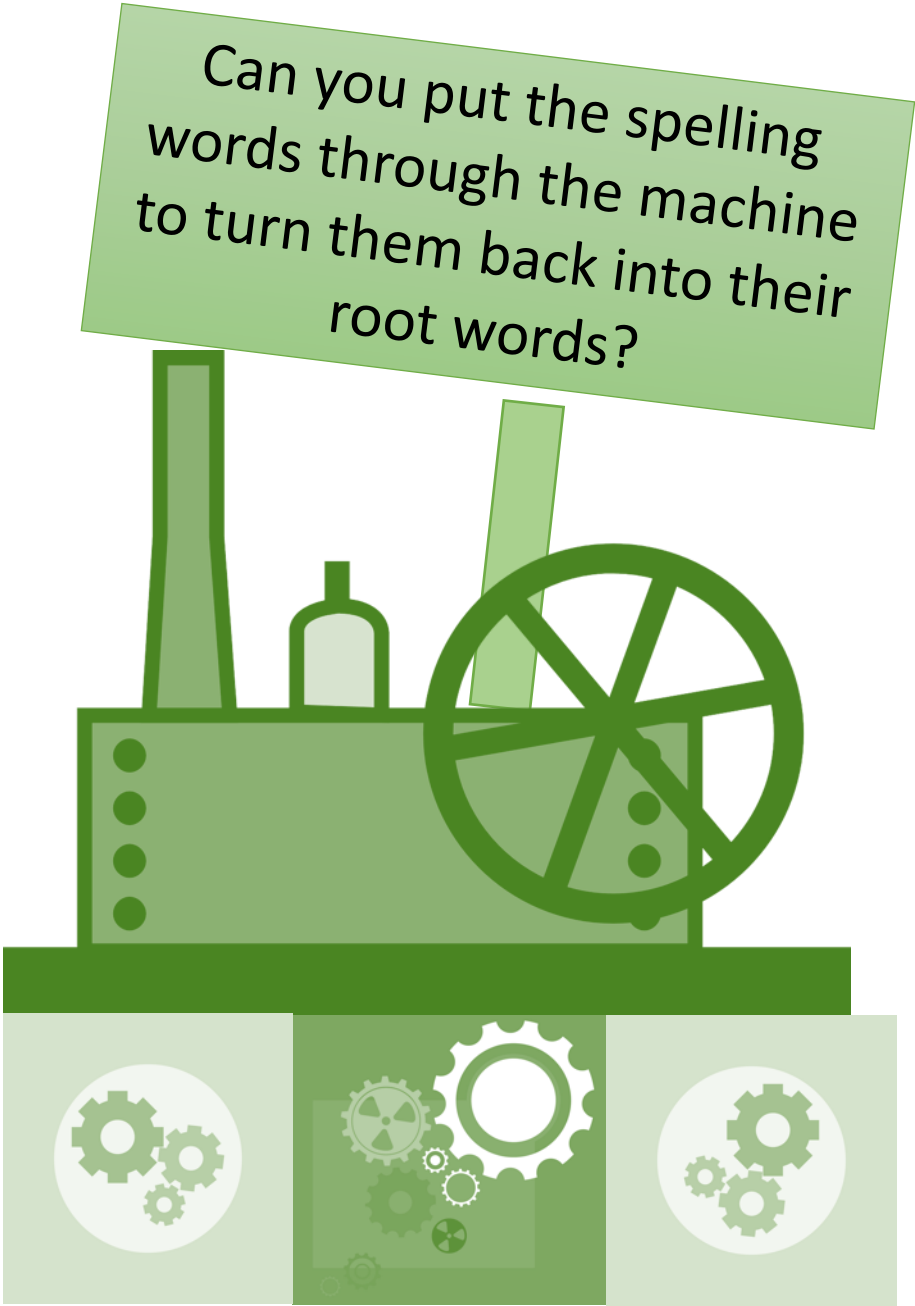


In root words like this, where the last syllable is stressed, you need to double the final consonant of the word before adding the suffix.
