Sports Week

Our annual Sports Week took place last week, with children across the school taking part in a variety of sports and activities. Sports Day

Year 5 Alsager School Activity Day

On Tuesday 14th June, our Year 5 children attended at an activity day at Alsager School. During the day, they took part in three different lessons led by teaching staff from the high school. These sessions involved a wide variety of activities: in science, they investigated which of the teachers was an alien by carrying out a series of chemical tests, such as figuring out the pH of a liquid;

the children developed their skills in typography in DT; in English, they learnt about Macbeth and created their own potion for the mischievous witches; and in food technology they decorated their own biscuits. Year 5 were an absolute credit to Excalibur – well done to you all.
