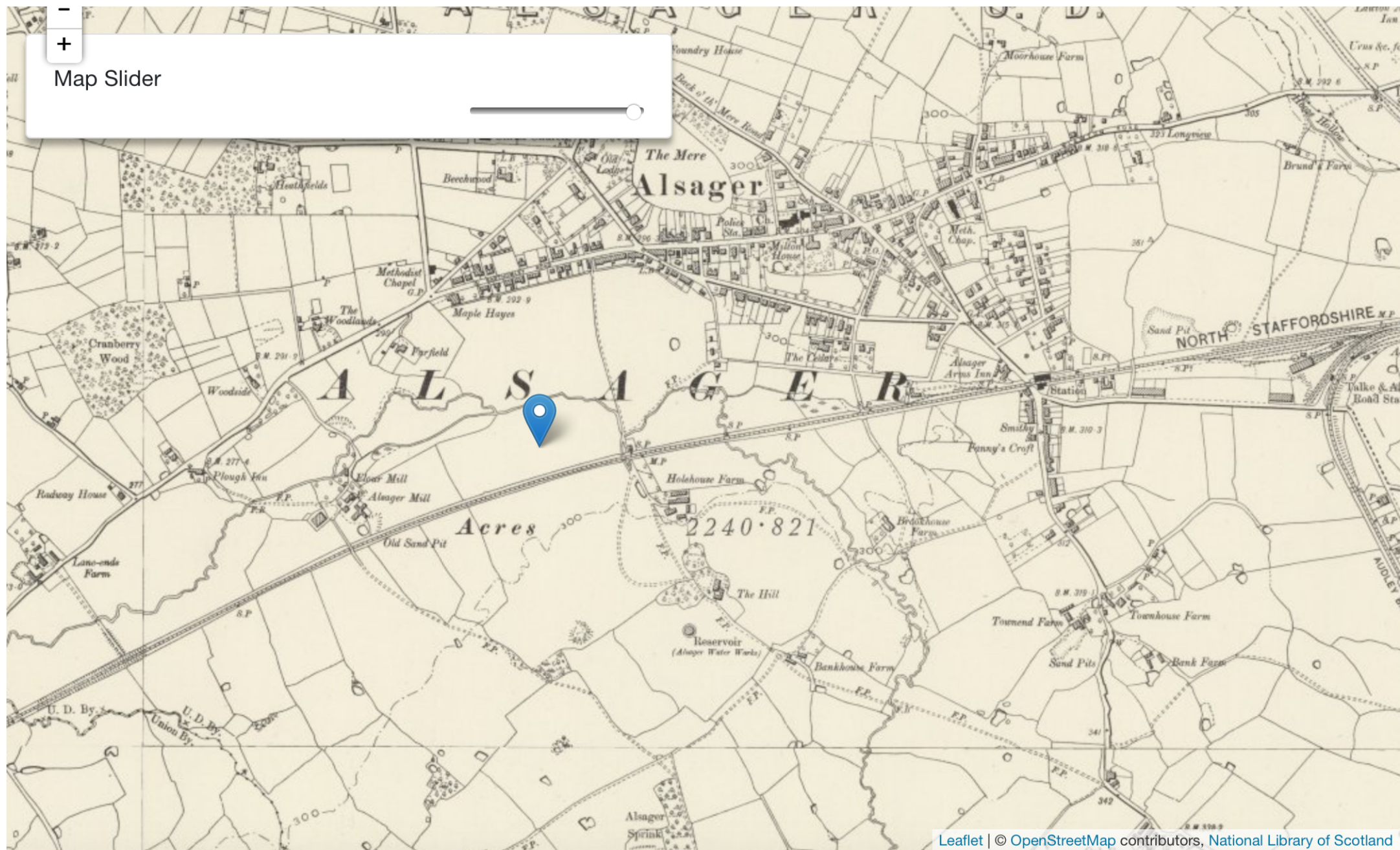


Modern map of Alsager

Map Activities

You have two maps in your pack.

- Old map of Alsager (1888 - 1913)
- Modern map of Alsager.

What are the differences between the two maps?

What are the similarities between the two maps?

Can you find Excalibur on the maps? Are there any other places you recognise?

Can you recognise the symbols which mark out local areas of interest? E.g. railway line, roads, houses, fields. You might want to draw your own map of Alsager using your own key to show the local areas of interest.

Geography Project

We need to find out as much information as we can about Alsager. Choose some of the following to research and investigate. You may be able to do this through online research, creating questions for other people to answer (survey) or by investigating yourself.

- Conduct your own survey - What shops / factories / schools / fields / local attractions / places of interest are in Alsager?
- How many schools? - can you find this by using the modern map? HINT: schools are marked in yellow!
- Traffic survey - you could count the cars you can see from a window in your house for 10 minutes.
