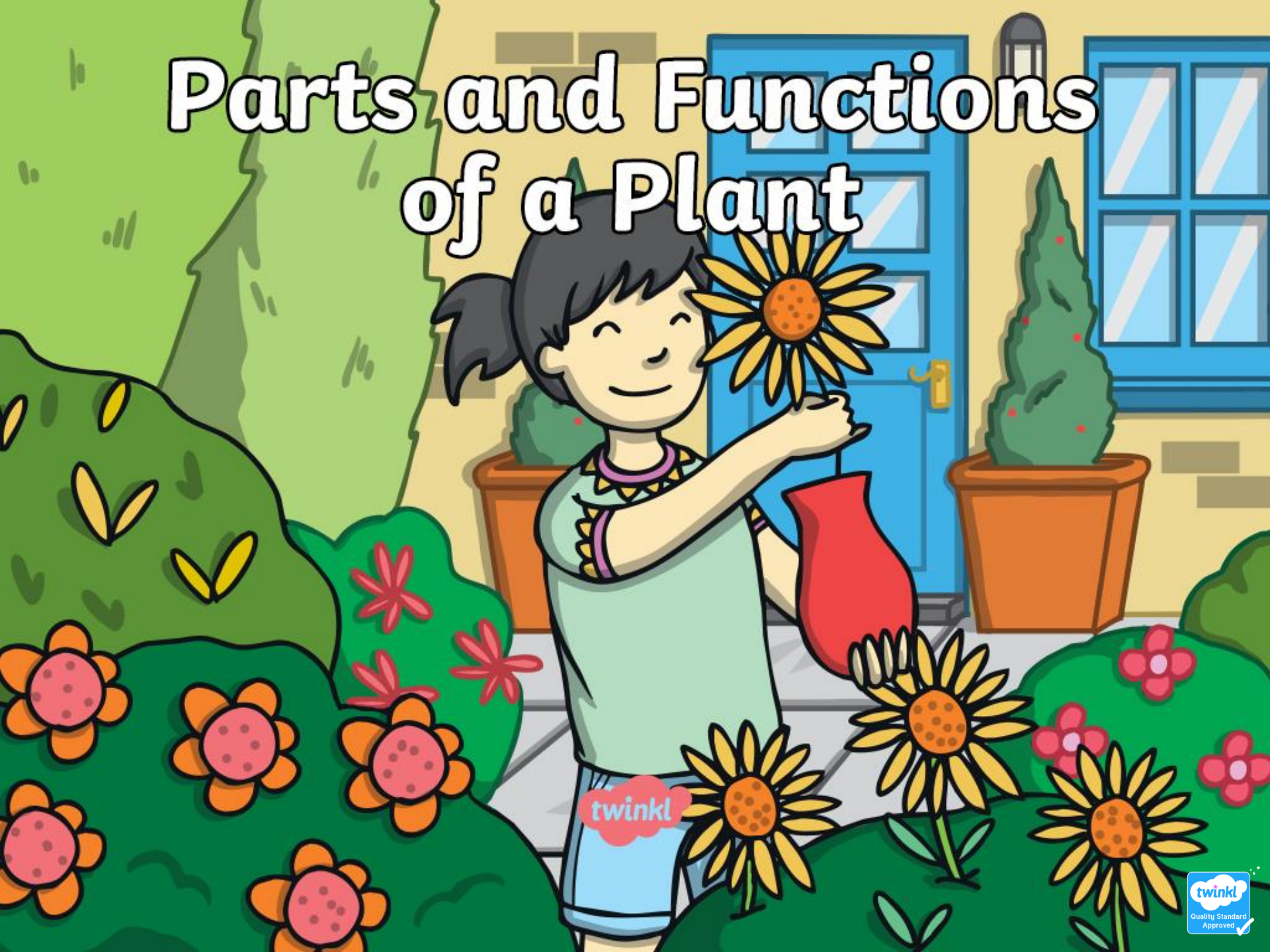

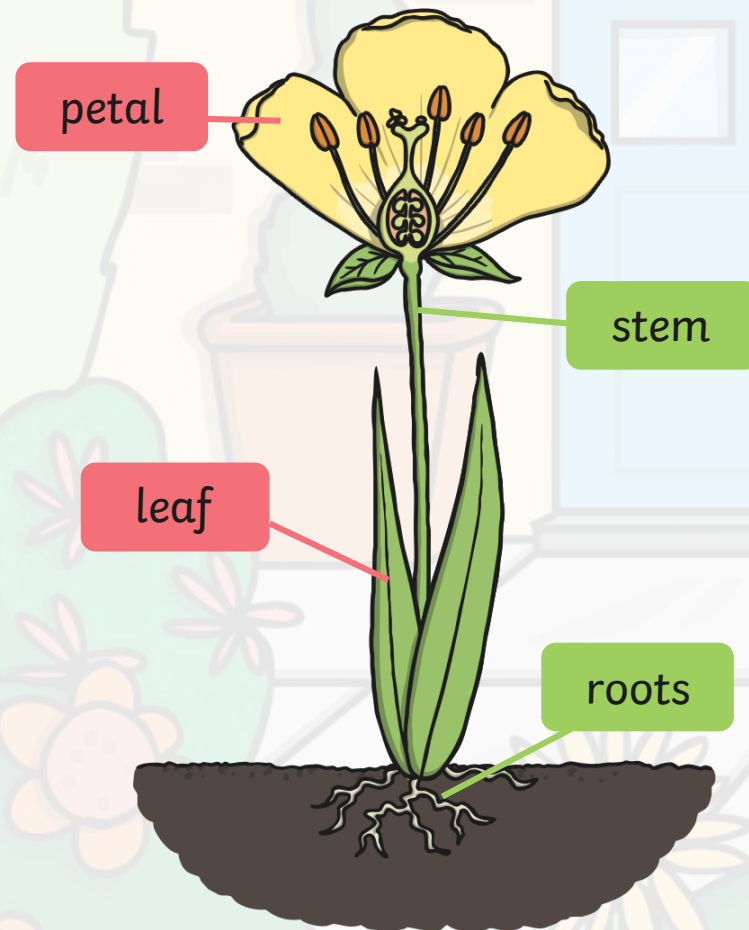

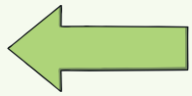




# Parts and Functions of a Plant

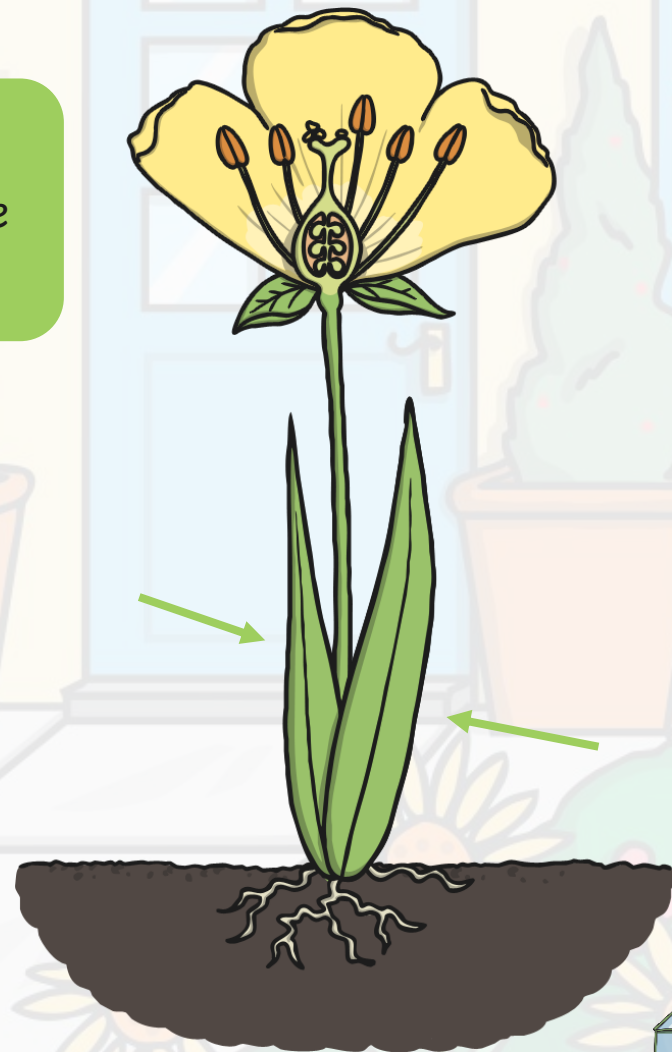
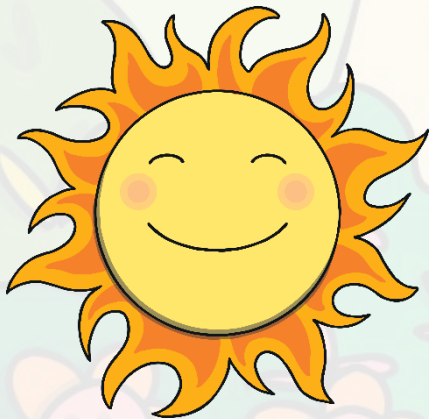

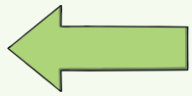




# Leaf

Leaves make food for the plant from carbon dioxide in the air and sunlight.



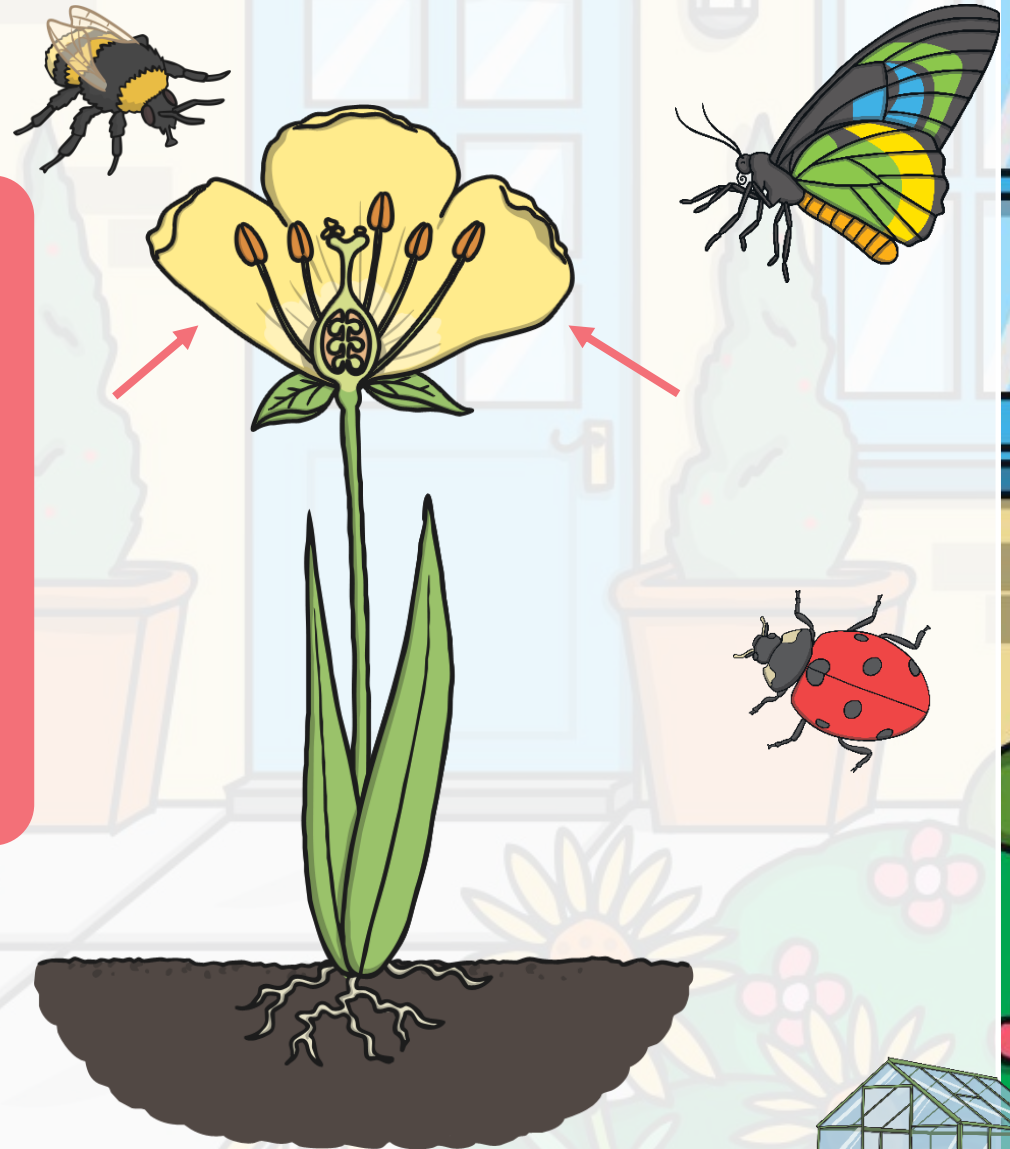


# Petal

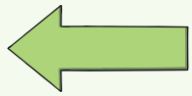
Petals attract insects to the plant.

Plants need insects to bring pollen they have collected from other flowers so they can make seeds.

Petals are bright colours to attract the insects.

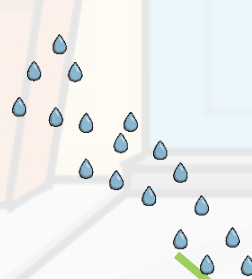
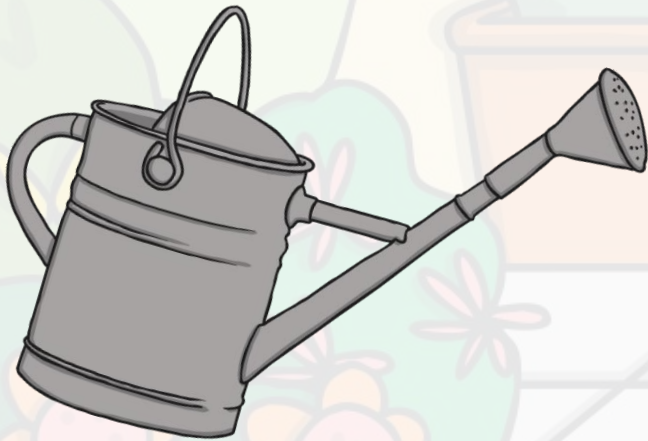


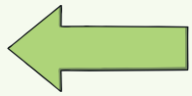




# Roots

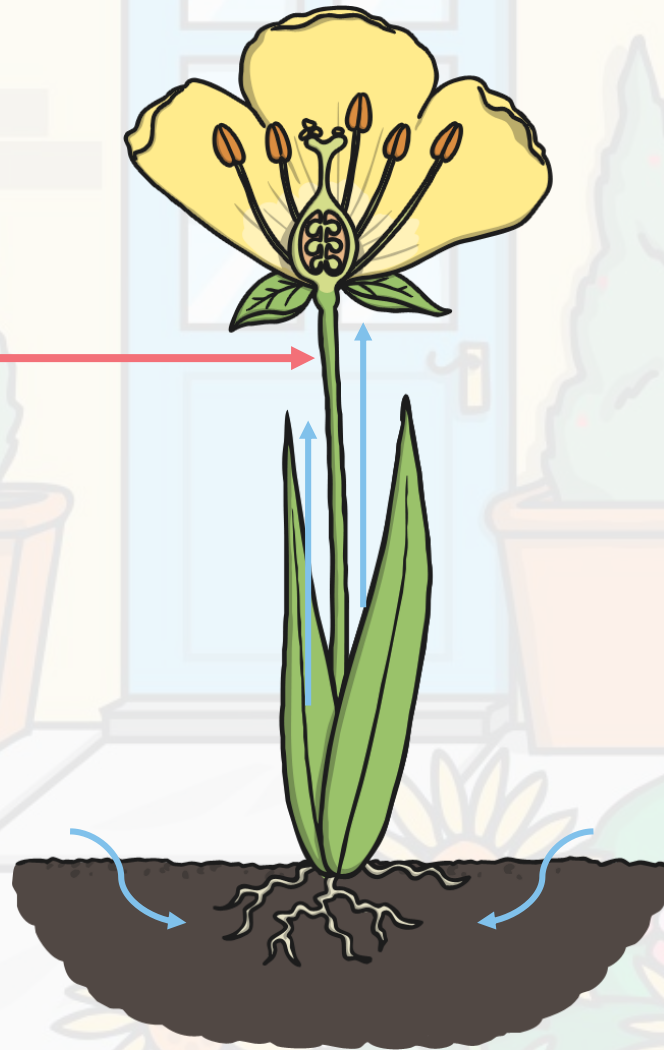
Roots absorb minerals and water from the soil. The roots also help the plant anchor in the soil and stay upright.





# Stem

The stem transports water around the plant. It also holds the plant upright so it can get more sunlight.

<u>Part of the Plant</u>	<u>Function</u>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*Supports the plant and holds it upright so it can get more sunlight.</li><li>*Transports water and nutrients around the plant.</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*Makes food for the plant using sunlight and carbon dioxide from the air.</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*Anchors the plant in the ground.</li><li>*Takes water and nutrients from the soil.</li><li>*Have hairs to absorb more water.</li></ul>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>*Are bright colours to attract insects.</li><li>*Produces seeds or fruit.</li><li>*Helps the plant to reproduce through pollination.</li><li>*Makes nectar that insects feed on.</li></ul>
