#### **Year 1 Blue Planet Trip**

## Computing with Raj in Year 2, 4 & 6

Over the last couple of weeks, our Year 2, 4 & 6 children have benefitted from computing sessions with Raj Barard. The children have worked on CoSpaces, an online coding programme where they were able to code in a 3D space. Year 2 learnt how to move their characters around the space while Year 6 developed parallel codes and multiple scenes. It was a great opportunity for our children to develop their knowledge of computer programmes.

#### Science in Year 2

Year 2 have been developing their skills of scientific enquiry by exploring whether sounds get fainter the further away they are. The children worked well to observe and make records of their observations, before concluding what their findings showed. Year 2 are clearly a class full of future scientists!
