We have begun to share the story of Christmas, which the children performed 'helicopter story' style, and to learn the songs we will be singing during our nativity. We have continued to learn the set one sounds during Read Write Inc. Our new sounds this week are r, j and v. Some of the children are becoming increasingly secure with CVC words e.g. Cat. Other children are only able to say the CVC word when an adult segments it for them. Reading skills take time to develop and children often suddenly have a spurt when it all begins to make sense. Everyone is doing really well and we are so proud of them. Thank you for everything you are doing at home too.

We have been putting the finishing touches to our Christmas tree decorations. We were due to have a tree in the annual Wesley place Christmas Tree Festival. It does however mean that we get to have our tree up a little earlier at school and that the Children will be able to help to decorate it too as they can't when it is down at the church.

'Stanley's Stick' and 'It's Not a Stick' provided a stimulus for some of our learning this week. Sticks are just so wonderfully versatile! (A bit like beanbags.) We will be using Julia Donaldson's 'Stick Man' next week as the 'fantastick' stick theme continues!
