
Snakes are quite easy pets to take care of. They come in different sizes.




Snakes have cold blood so they need heat from lamps or mats to help stay warm.



What does a snake need?




What do I need to remember about having a snake?

Snakes are meat-eaters but don't need to be fed very often. Their skin can feel a bit strange and cold but it is fine to hold them gently. They need to get used to being held and they like it if your hands are warm.

How do I keep a snake healthy?

Snakes need to live in a place that is quite damp and warm. This helps them to move around and to shed their skin. If they get too dry, their skin gets tight and they will need to go to the vet.



Snakes are an unusual pet to have but they are not too difficult to take care of. Although some snakes are dangerous, most are safe to keep as pets.



What Does a Snake Look Like?

Snakes have a long, thin body. They do not have any legs; they move around by wriggling their body. Unlike many other pets, their skin is covered in scales and they are cold-blooded so they feel cold to the touch. They use their eyes to see and tongue to smell and taste the air.



What Does a Snake Need?

Snakes need a tank, or terrarium, to live in. The bigger the snake, the bigger the tank. It is also essential that they have somewhere to hide in the tank where it is dark. Although snakes are cold-blooded, they don't want to be hot all the time. Therefore, only a section of the tank needs to have a heat mat or a lamp. There should also be cool areas for the snake to spend time in.






What Else Do I Need to Keep a Snake Healthy?

Most pet snakes need to live in a place that is quite damp and warm because that would replicate their home in the wild. Being warm gives them energy to move around easily. Snakes shed their skin once a month and it is replaced with a healthy, bigger skin. The moist air enables them to shed their skin. If they get too dry, it gets tight and they will need to go to the vet.

What Do Snakes Eat?

Depending on the size and species, most snakes will eat smaller animals such as, reptiles, insects, mice and birds. Snakes don't need to eat very often so should be fed once a week. When snakes become hungry their tongue flicks may increase and they will search their tank looking for prey.
