


Handwriting Paper

Always start your letter on the writing line - the bottom blue line.

- Some letters are tall like 'd' and 'h'. They must touch the **red** line above.
- Some letters descend below the writing line like 'g' and 'y'. They must touch the **red** line below.
- Some letters fit between the blue lines like 'a' and 'e'. They must sit on the bottom **blue** line and touch the **blue** line above, just like in school.
