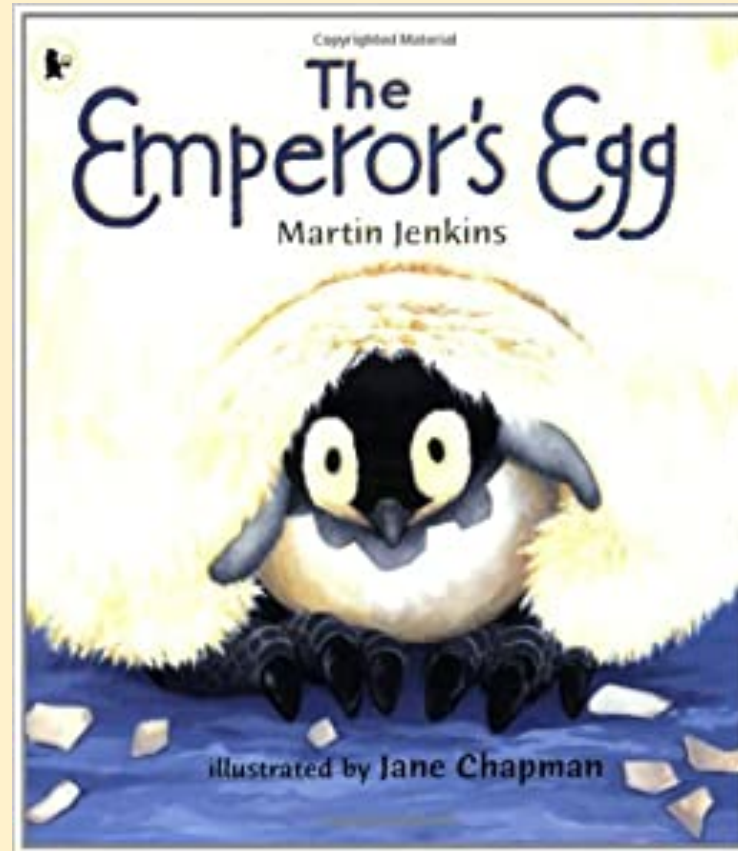

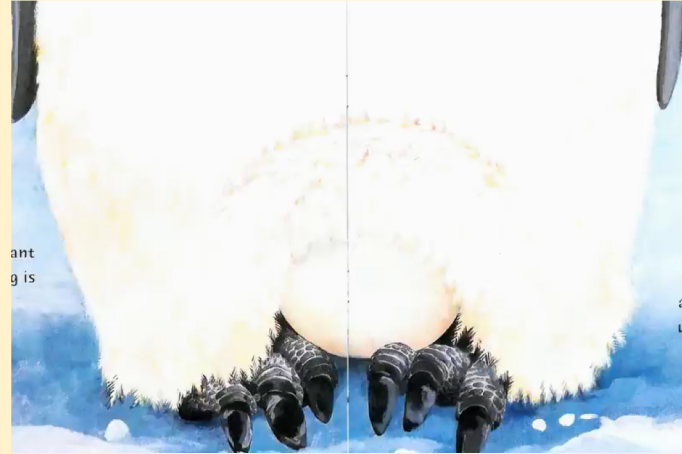

<p><b><u>What is the male Emperor penguin's job?</u></b></p> <p>“take good care of the egg”</p>	<p><b><u>What happens to the character in the story?</u></b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>• Female penguin spends most of winter swimming and hunting.</li><li>• Male penguin looks after the egg until it hatches.</li><li>• No food for two months.</li></ul>
