In Literacy we have been enjoying some role-play opportunities and have been hearing some wonderful pirate adventures.



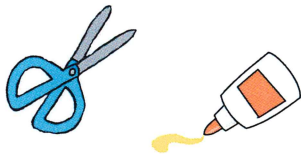
In Maths we continued to focus on problem solving and investigations. The children enjoyed their maths workshop and the chance to investigate shape.
