

Treasure box

Treasure boxes are like chatter boxes and can be filled with things for your child to talk about. Your child can decorate the outside of their box to make it bright and interesting.

Treasures can include:

- Family photos and pictures of pets
- Photos of them as a baby, as a toddler, during special occasions.
- Holiday postcards or souvenirs from day trips
- Natural objects that they have found on a walk, at the park, or on the beach.
- Objects that have memories attached e.g. something they wore as a baby, a baby toy, a favourite story, or a picture of their favourite character.

The treasure boxes will be kept in school for the first half-term so don't include something really special that your child will need back straight away. Please make sure the box is clearly labelled with your child's name.

We will look through the objects and talk with your child on a one-to-one basis. Please include labels or notes, where possible, to help to prompt your child if they forget or feel a little shy. It can also help if you can spend a little time talking through the treasure box items before they bring it into school.
