It has been another busy week in Reception. The children have been exploring the outside resources and have been learning to work as part of a team. They have enjoyed creating dens, obstacle courses and stages for performances. They have also had great fun channeling water using guttering pipes.

We have been busy learning our funky fingers routine and the children have loved showing their moves at the dough disco. They have also coped really well when changing for PE. All of the children tried hard to manage their own clothing and fastens. They were confident when moving around the hall and tried hard to dodge to avoid collision.

In maths, we have continued our number songs and have looked closely at the months of the year. We talked about our birthday months and noticed where our photographs were on the birthday balloon display. The children enjoyed learning a new song to help remember the sequence and names of the months.

The children have been trying hard to write their own name from memory. Some children were able to name the letter sounds in their own name. They have also created a line drawing of themselves to go on display in the classroom.
