Dear Parents and Carers,

Happy New Year and welcome to the Spring Term. I hope you had a lovely Christmas holiday. I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for my Christmas gifts. I had a lot of fun opening them.

Our topic this term is 'The Great Fire of London' and we will be reading dragon stories. The Stuarts is a very dramatic period of history. Famous people from this time include: Samuel Pepys, Pocahontas, Sir Christopher Wren and Isaac Newton. On Friday 20th January Year 2 are taking part in a 'Great Fire of London' workshop. This has been very successful in previous years. A letter will follow with more details.

In maths we will be continuing with our tables - 2x, 5x 10x and 3x tables. Year 2 children now have individual logins for Times Tables Rock stars. ## Homework

MyMaths homework or a sheet to reinforce and revise classwork will be set or glued into homework books each week. Reading and spelling homework will be sent home on Fridays and returned the following Wednesday.
