Operation Encompass

In partnership with Cheshire Police, Excalibur Primary School is involved in a project called Operation Encompass. The purpose of Operation Encompass is to safeguard and support children and young people who have been involved in, heard or witnessed a domestic abuse incident. Following such an incident, children will often arrive at school distressed, upset, worried and unprepared. Operation Encompass aims to ensure that relevant information is passed to nominated school staff, key adults, to support children and young people in a way that means they feel safe and included. Key adults are trained to liaise with the police and ensure support is available to the child.
