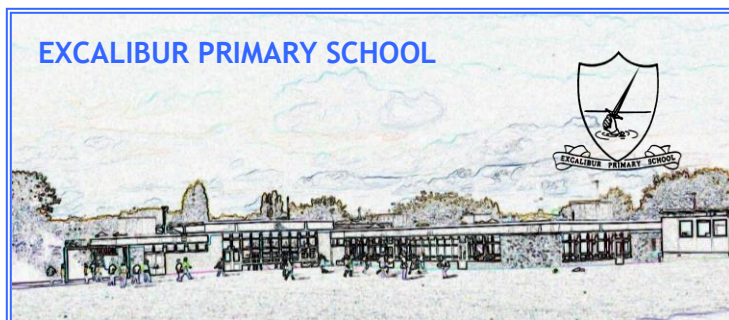

Key Stage 1 SATs Information

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you will be aware children in Year 2 are required to undertake national curriculum tests (commonly called SATs) during the month of May. The children will be tested in Reading Comprehension and Mathematics. The tests are not strictly timed and most children will not realise that they are taking them as the tests will be incorporated into normal classroom practice.

Subject	Test paper
English: reading comprehension	Paper 1: short text and questions Paper 2: longer text with separate questions
Mathematics	Paper 1: arithmetic Paper 2: reasoning

Writing is also assessed during this time using everyday classroom writing. The results from these tests, along with the work your child has completed throughout the year, will be used to make a judgment about how your child is progressing by the end of Key Stage 1. These teacher assessment judgments will be reported to you by the end of the summer term.

Teacher assessment judgment	Test paper
PKS	Pupil is working below the test standard
WTS	Pupil is working towards the expected standard for Year 2
EXS	Pupil is working at the expected standard for Year 2
GDS	Pupil is working at a greater depth within the expected standard for Year 2
