touch The children have been finding out about their senses as we continue our topic "Marvellous Me". We have also spent time thinking about kind hands and what they can and can't do.



We have been doing our usual counting activities, counting forwards and backwards with numbers to 20. We have also been doing more data handling activities and the children have asked their friends "Which is your favourite fruit?"

In Read, Write Inc., we looked closely at the sound and formation of i, n, and p. The children have enjoyed trying to build CVC words using magnetic letter tiles. We have practised saying each sound and then sweeping underneath with our "Pointer of Power" (which is actually a regular ice lolly stick!)
