This week, the children have experienced a variety of activities planned around the familiar Nursery Rhyme 'Humpty Dumpty'. In sensory play, the children tried to build a strong wall for Humpty, with a foamy mixture, used to glue the wall together. It was very messy but great fun! We practised our scissor skills, cutting up a Humpty jigsaw and sticking him back together. The children concentrated beautifully as they cut up the jigsaw pieces. Later, everyone enjoyed giving first aid to Humpty Dumpty as we stuck him together with sticking plasters.



The children really enjoyed their visit to the school library this week. <u>A reminder that library books need to be</u> <u>returned on **Thursday**</u> so that books can be swapped.

Next Wednesday morning, Pre-school will be heading to the hall for our 'music and movement' lesson.
