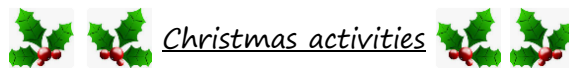
Pre-school Weekly Newsletter

EYFS Nativity

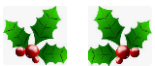
