Welcome to our new starters

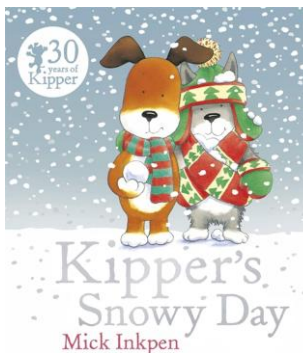
Our new starters have made a super start to pre-school. Everyone has been busy making friends and getting used to the routine. Well done everyone!
