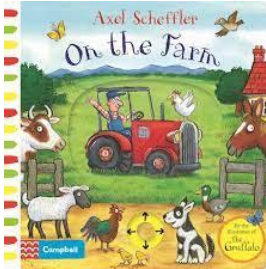

Our story of the week was 'On the Farm'.

We have had a busy week in pre-school and have enjoyed the sunshine with some outdoor activities.

During the week, the children enjoyed making Mother's Day cards and we talked about helping make Mother's Day a special time. The children also found out facts about spring and the signs that show spring has arrived. We went on a couple of spring walks, around the school grounds. Everyone used their senses to make observations about what we could see, hear and feel. The children spotted the new buds and lots of daffodils. We also talked about the birds we heard singing. Later, everyone tried hard to learn some new topic songs including 'Sunglasses' and 'Caterpillar'.

During maths, we have shared some consolidation activities, from our learning so far. We also explored capacity as we explored 'full' and 'empty'. Our song of this week was "Goldilocks and the house of the bears".
