

Pre-school Weekly Newsletter Term: Summer one Week: five



During the week, the children have been taking part in some bee themed activities. On Tuesday, we celebrated 'World Bee Day'. The children found out about bees and why bees are important. They have also enjoyed a selection of bee related crafts including making a 'bee protector hat'.

In maths, we have been exploring 3D shapes and looking at their properties. We recognised and named cuboid, cube, sphere and cylinder. We also used language to describe the shape properties e.g. face, solid, sides, curve, corners, points etc. The children enjoyed building bridges with the wooden blocks to see which would balance more successfully. They also had an outdoor shape hunt. Our maths rhyme of the week was 'London Bridge is Falling Down.

This week, we have been spending much of our time outdoors. The children have explored water brushing, pavement chalking and construction. The bikes and trikes have been a popular choice and we have had to remind the children to slow down as they're getting very confident! Everyone has also loved using the adventure playground to travel through, over and under.
